To: All Bellshill Pipeline Producers and Shippers

Re: Bellshill Pipeline Crude Stream Selection Process

Following our letter of June 29th, wherein Gibson indicated that it would no longer batch crude oil on the Bellshill Pipeline, we have endeavored to work with our producers to provide some flexibility in which crude stream service the pipeline will be operated on a month-by-month basis. As this has caused some of our customers some challenges, we are prepared to offer the following process on a trial basis for battery operators to request crude volumes move as either Bow River or Hardisty Light stream;

The Bellshill Pipeline will be in Bow River service unless, pursuant to the following process, the pipeline is determined by Gibson to be in Hardisty Light service for the subsequent month:

1. On or before noon of the second workday in a forecasting month, Battery Operators may request in writing to Gibson Shipper Services at shipperservices@gibsons.com that Gibson change the Bellshill Pipeline to Hardisty Light service; the absence of a request for Hardisty Light service will be deemed to be a request for Bow River service;
2. By 4:00 pm of workday 2, Gibson Shipper Services will consolidate the requests by rolling three-month historical average volume and advise the battery operators the result of the requests, and will also advise in which stream service the Bellshill Pipeline will be operating in the subsequent month.
3. By 2:00 pm of workday 4, Form A's due for P/L connected batteries to Feeder P/L's per COLC calendar.

This timeline will provide all shippers an equitable amount of the trading cycle to market their crude.

This process will be effective for the March forecast month, April production month, and will continue until terminated or revisions are implemented.
