Gibson Responds to Grande Prairie Incident

Mr. Gord Herman, Gibson's Vice President of Truck Transportation-Marketing & Business Development, advises that, at approximately 7:30 a.m. this morning, a fire was reported at Gibson Energy's truck transportation shop & wash-bay facilities in Grande Prairie, Alberta. The area was immediately secured by local emergency personnel. All employees on site as well as workers in nearby facilities were safely evacuated as a precaution. There were no injuries or casualties as a result of the fire.

An investigation into the cause of the fire, the extent of the damage, etc. is underway; Gibson's local and head office representatives are cooperating fully with the appropriate authorities and regulators to conclude that investigation.
