



PRESS RELEASE – GIBSON ENERGY ULC EDMONTON TERMINAL INCIDENT

Mr. Frank Janzen, Gibson's Vice President of Terminals and Pipelines advises that, earlier today, a small fire was reported and extinguished in one of the crude oil tanks at the Gibson Edmonton (Strathcona County) Terminal. The cause of the fire remains under investigation at this point in time.

There were no injuries to individuals as a result of this incident, which occurred while the affected tank was shut down and had been emptied for routine maintenance.

Gibson Safety personnel are on the scene and will continue to work with local regulatory authorities.

Although the terminal was temporarily shut down as a precaution, there are not anticipated to be any material business interruption impacts.

Gibson Energy is committed to maintaining high standards of health, safety and environmental excellence. In response to this incident, **Gibson's primary concern is for the safety of their employees and the public, as well as for the protection of the environment.**
