Mr. R. M. (Rick) Wise, Senior Vice President, Operations advises that, at approximately 4:00 p.m. on June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010, a fire was reported at Gibson's (Bridge Creek) Gull Lake Saskatchewan Terminal. It's believed that the fire was started by a lightning strike.

There were no employees or visitors on the site at the time of the incident, we are pleased to report that there were no injuries as a result of this incident.

Both the Gull Lake and Swift Current Fire Departments responded and set up a "safety zone" in the area around the fire, which was extinguished later that day. Gibson's Safety personnel are also on the scene and will continue to work with local and regional authorities with the ongoing investigation.

Clean up of the site surrounding the fire will commence later today.

Due to the proximity of a nearby alternate Gibson terminal, local employees and customers can expect "business as usual".
